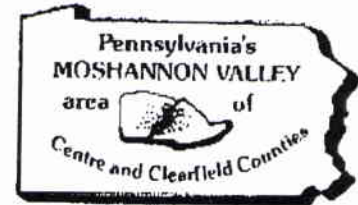

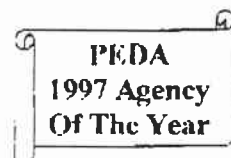
As you know, the Board of Directors of the Moshannon Valley Economic Development Partnership, Inc. has come out in support of the proposed landfill and industrial park project that Resource Recovery LLC has proposed for Rush Township. Enclosed is a copy of our May 14, 2007 letter to Dan Klees, Chairman of the Centre County Metropolitan Planning Organization. Our support is conditional upon the development of a new interchange from Interstate 80 to the site.

**The MVEDP is herewith respectfully requesting the Chamber of Business & Industry of Centre County, Inc. to support Resource Recovery LLC's landfill and industrial park project proposed for Rush Township.**

You are well-aware of the financial difficulties faced by our Philipsburg-Osceola Area School District. Most of our Moshannon Valley municipalities are also financially strapped. All have small population figures making them ineligible for entitlement dollars from the federal government. The closing of the Philipsburg Area Hospital has exacerbated the problem that we have with a very limited tax base, to say nothing of the lost jobs due to that closure.

The Resource Recovery landfill proposal presents an opportunity for our area to experience some very real economic and community development success. The revenues that will accrue to Rush Township and the P-O Area School District will result in a financially stronger school district, and many projects in the Rush Township area that will improve the quality of life in this region.


