Gentlemen:

You are hereby granted a waiver from the requirement to obtain a permit for noncoal exploration under 25 Pa. Code 77.109 for the above mentioned permit waiver request.

Although a waiver of permit is granted, the exploration activities must be conducted in accordance with 25 Pa. Code Chapter 77, Sub chapter C and all applicable State and Federal Laws, Rules and Regulations. The noncoal exploration activities are subject to the applicable inspection and enforcement provisions of 25 Pa. Code Chapter 77, Sub chapters E and F.

The amount of noncoal material under this permit waiver shall be limited to:

125 tons noncoal material

Maximum disturbed acreage shall not exceed 1 acre.

Erosion and sedimentation controls shall be installed to comply with Chapter 102.

All noncoal material removed under this waiver of permit must be used for testing and analysis of noncoal materials.

You are approved for the time period of July 3, 2006 through July 3, 2007. **NOTE: ITE'S CAN ONLY BE FOR ONE YEAR.**
